WHAT IS CLEAN MEAT?

Clean meat, also known as lab-grown meat, cultured meat, or cultivated meat, is meat produced by in vitro cultivation of animal cells, rather than by traditional animal agriculture. It's essentially meat grown in a lab setting, without the need to raise and slaughter animals.

What is lab grown meat produced from?

How is cultivated meat made?

The manufacturing process begins with acquiring and banking stem cells from an animal. These cells are then grown in bioreactors (known colloquially as cultivators) at high densities and volumes.

Does the US approve lab-grown meat?

The Department of Agriculture recently approved the production of what's known as cultivated meat, which is chicken grown in a lab. That approval clears the way for companies to begin selling poultry produced from animal cells rather than animals bred in factory farms and killed.
