Curious, intelligent and playful- Turkeys are inquisitive and enjoy exploring. They are playful individuals with unique personalities.

Social, gentle and loyal - Turkeys form strong social bonds. They are also bonded to their young and will courageously defend their families against predators.

Vocal and emotional- Turkeys are highly vocal and the sound of the flock can indicate social tensions. You can tell turkeys' emotions by the color of their heads. The more intense the colors, the more intense their emotions.

Turkeys raised for human consumption are crowded into poorly ventilated industrial production facilities, sometimes with as many as 15,000 birds packed into a single factory building.
